2. During the current month, we have received the requisite information/comments from the State Government/ UT of **Chattisgarh, Daman and Diu, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal** regarding the number of claims received and titles distributed/ready for distribution and extent of forest land. The requisite information/report has not been received from other States/UTs in respect of monthly progress report (MPR).

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Readiness of the States in the implementation of the Act:

- (i) An updated status of State-wise implementation of the Act is given in **Annexure-I**. As per the information collected till **31st May, 2015, 43,63,114 claims** (42,51,118 individual, 1,07,182 community & **4814 CFR claims) **have been filed and 16,54,431 titles** (16,17,016 individual, 35,267 community and *2148 CFR claims) **have been distributed. A total of 35,15,289 (80.57%) claims have been disposed of.** Pending population of the web-site (www.forestrights.gov.in), a statement on claims received and distribution of title deeds in various states, as in **Annexure-II**, is being maintained.

**only the State Government of Odisha and West Bengal has provided disaggregated data on CFR claims.

Barring few pockets of land under wildlife sanctuaries, reserved forests, most of the land in entire State is community land. Territorial boundaries of land and forest belonging to different communities or tribes are also identified in the same line leaving no scope for any dispute over the possession of land, forest and water bodies among the tribes. Therefore, Forest Rights Act does not have much relevance in Arunachal Pradesh.</p>	-
