# Rights and Concession in Ghumsur South Division

(1) Only commutation fee at a fixed rate (annually) is realised in Chandragiri Range.

### (2) In Reserved Forests -

T

No right to forest produce except those admitted to Kondhas. The Kondh residents are allowed free removal of timber dry firewood and bamboes required for their own bona fide use and also free removal of M. F. P. in lieu of certain services, like fire protection to be rendered by them.

### (3) In Unreserved Forests -

The concessions admitted in general to local tribes are free removal of timber dry firewood, bamboos. M. F. Ps. for domestic use only. Free grazing is also allowed.
