Timber .. Unreserved trees for agricultural and domestic purposes free with permission when not available in Khesra forests.

Firewood ... Unreserved species free

Bamboo .. Free when not available in Khesra Forests with permission. Juanga with permission around Malayagiri allowed free bamboos for basket making for sale.

M. F. P. .. Tenants allowed from coupes at concessional rates. Poor tenants and Adibasis free with permission. (Edible fruits, roots, creepers and leaves for Juangs) and for others grass and fodder free.

Grazing .. No free grazing

Bamboo .. At concessional rate Re. 1-0-0 per hundred. Tenants Re. 0-12-0 per hundred.

M. F. P. .. Edible roots, fruits free

Grazing .. No free grazing

In Khesra forests or Un-reserves or U. D. P.

Fs.—

Timber .. Unreserved species free without permission. Reserved species at tenant's rate ($\frac{1}{2}$ rate). Reserved species for agricultural implements free after marking.

Firewood .. Unreserved species free

Bamboo .. Free

M. F. P. .. Free

Grazing .. Free
