


Sub: Proposals for inclusion of additional PVTG villages in the existing Micro-Projects of the State of Odisha –Reg.

205-II
I am directed to refer to ST&SC Development, Department, Government of Odisha communication no.17898/SSD dated 27.09.2016(Copy enclosed) on the above mentioned subject. In this connection it is pointed out that PVTG identification criteria is different and not based on inclusion of Villages in Micro Projects but on whether the individual belongs to the community identified as PVTG by the Ministry of Home Affairs. It is clarified here that PVTG funds cannot be spent on non-PVTGs STs. If wholesome micro-project for PVTG has some non-PVTG ST population, then funds from State or from Article 275(1) or SCA to TSP funds of Ministry of Tribal Affairs funds should be used for catering to non-PVTG ST population in those areas. Dove-tailing/Deviation of funds in this manner of PVTG community in adjacent areas outside existing PVTG boundary should be covered in the Micro Projects set up for PVTGs.

Sub.:- Proposals for inclusion of additional PVTG villages in the existing Micro-Projects of the State of Odisha.

Sir,
I am directed to inform that thirteen communities have been designated as PVTGs in Odisha and for their all-round development; seventeen Micro-Projects have been established during different Plan periods. There are some villages in close proximity of the existing Micro Project boundary who have been claiming for inclusion in the micro projects so that they can get the status of PVTGs and can avail of the benefits that are extended to the PVTGs.

In the meantime, proposals have been received from as many as six Micro Projects for inclusion of same tribal communities staying in some additional villages in the existing Micro Projects. SCSTRTI in the mean time have consolidated the name of the villages and is recommending to consider inclusion of the ST households of these additional villages in the existing Micro Projects and also to consider them as PVTGs with a view to be covered under the scheme of Development of PVTGs & CCD Plans. A statement indicating name of the villages, Micro-Project & PVTG wise along with house-hold and population details is enclosed herewith. It is requested that the proposal may be considered by the Ministry for including these additional 305 villages within the existing six Micro-Projects.
